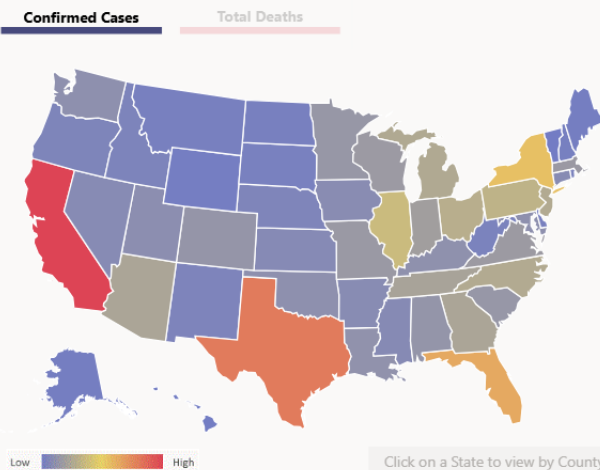

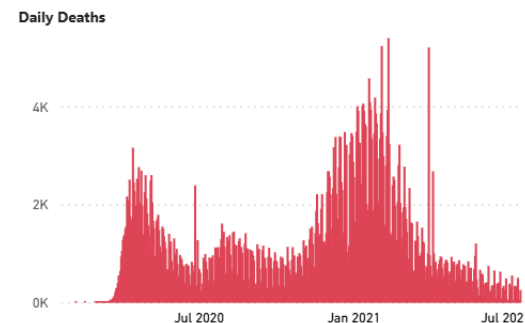
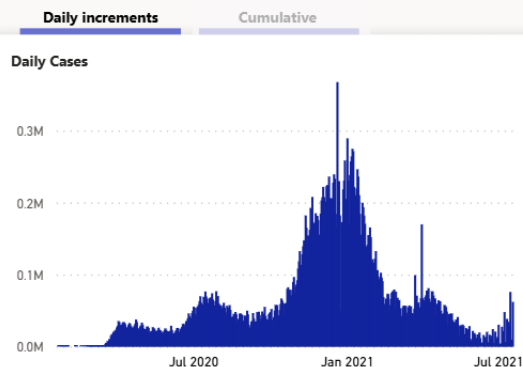
Methodology
